## **ORDER**

The Court hereby authorizes a fourth distribution from the settlement fund to the class members (1) who successfully received the second disbursement, (2) who fell below the threshold to receive a third distribution, and (3) whose pro rata share of the remaining fund will be at least \$17.46. The Court finds this the fairest and most efficient means of effectuating a fourth distribution and assuring that the distribution checks are deposited. The Court further authorizes Class Counsel to pay \$61,210.52 to the claims administrator for outstanding administration costs incurred to date and to retain a fund of \$38,300 to pay the estimated fees and costs of the fourth distribution.

The distribution shall be made within twenty-one days of entry of this Order and the checks mailed shall expire sixty days following the date of the initial mailing of those checks so that a final accounting can be prepared within ninety days of the mailing.
